
Useful Knots for Straw Workers

The use of the correct knot will ensure that your work will look tidy. These sheets will help you tie the most suitable knot or hitch.


Clove Hitch




Transom Knot


Used to tie two straws together at right angles






Method 2 (using a Clove Hitch)



Ligature Knot

This knot is sometimes called the Surgeon's knot but the correct name for this knot is the Ligature knot. It is used to make a knot that will not slip.

This knot is used to join straw threads to create a longer thread.
